She sits on the Board of Directors of Premier Health, serves as the Immediate Past Chair of the Warren County Foundation, and plays a crucial role on the Executive Committee of the United Way of Warren County. As a prestigious Rodel Fellow, she is among the select few public servants nationally to have achieved this honor.

Married to Russell for thirty years, they share a love for the Cincinnati Bengals and the white sand beaches of Siesta Key.
